ARSEN ALCHIAN

1902-1991

With the passing of Bro. Arsen G. Alchian the Triple X Fraternity lost one of its last surviving Founding Fathers at the age of 89.

Funeral services for Arsen Alchian were held at the Lisle Funeral Home in Fresno with Fr. Sasoon Zumrukhdian officiating. Bro. Alchian died on Monday, Dec. 16, 1991 in Palm Springs, California.

Surviving are his wife Elise; a daughter Michele Silva of Torrance; a sister Gladys Fazio of Fresno.

We extend our heartfelt sympathies to his wife, Elise and other members of his family. May he rest in peace.

At this sad occasion our thoughts automatically go back to the early beginnings of our Fraternity. Since its founding in 1918, the Triple X Fraternity has grown into a strong and viable organization of close to 1000 members with 13 chapters in major cities of California. The following are a few notes excerpted from the 1933 'Trexmen.'

"Fifteen years ago, seven young Armenian boys met in Roeding Park, in Fresno, for the purpose of forming a 'Secret club.' Outside of that, their ideas were vague, unformed — like themselves. For this was a group of high school boys, and the seven of them — Charles Ashjian, Lee Dederian, Richard Dederian, Lee Rustigian, Armen Nishkian, Goorken Bacon, and John Kasparian — were too young to be interested in more serious or lasting projects. But the boys grew, as boys are wont to do; and as they did, the club grew with them. In a few years, the membership was more than doubled, and with this increase in age and number of members came the realization that they had in their hands an important instrument for bettering both themselves and their community. From a purely secret organization, they gradually changed to one which invited the whole community to participate; which sponsored worthwhile public projects that only an organized group could carry out successfully. Thus this club grew both in numbers and importance, until today that original group of seven has grown to one hundred.

"The first social event of this new organization christened, for no particular reason, 'The Triple-X Fraternity,' introduced them to the public of Fresno in a decisive fashion. This was a free invitational dance at the Marigold Ballroom and proved so very popular that it was repeated soon after. 'Triple X' was definitely a factor in Fresno social life.

"...We have sponsored other community projects. One of these was the entering of decorated cars in the nationally known Raisin Day Parade. Then at the funeral of General Antranik, which was held in Fresno, Triple X chartered an airplane to fly above the procession and scatter flowers over his grave. This act earned much favorable comment, as General Antranik was a greatly honored and beloved man. Then, during the years the Triple X boys were younger and more athletic, we entered a basketball team in the Fresno City League, and made a very favorable showing.

"... Other social activities, such as overnight outings, swimming parties, party dances, stage parties, horseshoe tournaments, etc., are held from time to time. These are usually for members and their families only, and are one of the most en-
