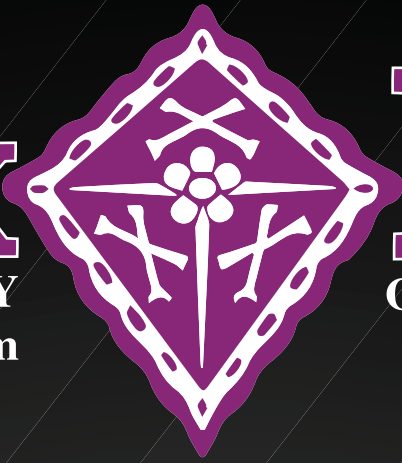

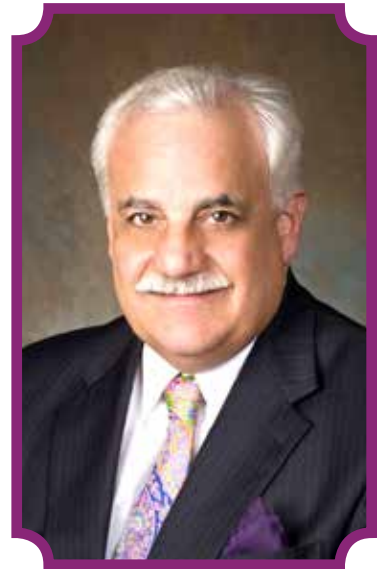
FROM THE GRAND MASTER...

(p.s. we have made a resolution to plan more combined events with our brother chapters in the Bay Area, so stay tuned!)

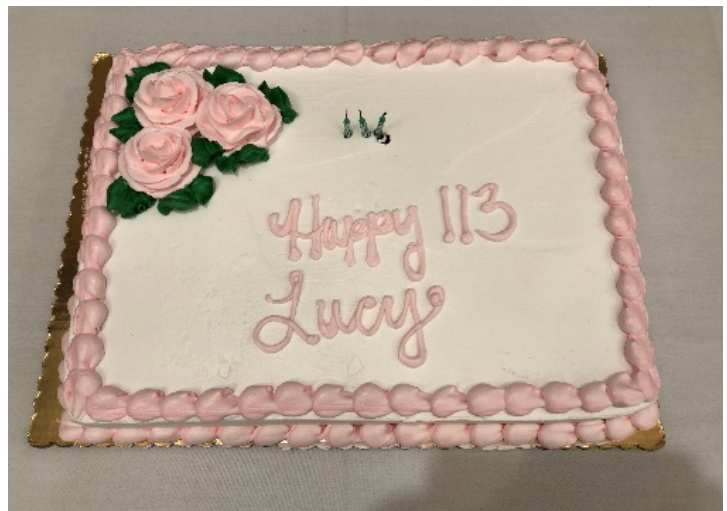
