
In closing I will start by saying this was one of the greatest honor in my life to serve my fraternal Brothers.


#### Brothers,



### Brother Aram A. Poladian, PGM Los Angeles Chapter September 27, 1921-April 28, 2023.

PGM Aram A. Poladian, a loving and devoted son, brother, husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather, was born Sept. 27, 1921, to Avedick and Naritza Poladian in Fresno, California. The family moved to Los Angeles in 1922 where he attended L.A. schools. He joined the US Coast Guard on December 8,

1941. Returning from military service in 1946, he worked at the family business, then Hovey Dallas Chevrolet, then Royalty Carpet Mills where he retired in 1984 and joined Los Coyotes Country Club where he pursued his passion for golf.

Aram married Pauline Hovey in Feb. of 1949 and living in Inglewood, they had four children, Aram Jr., Bob, Linda and Randy. He was an active member of the community, Los Angeles Chapter of Triple X Fraternity, attaining the distinguished title of Past Grand Master, and a member of the Al Malika Temple of Shriners. In 1975 he and Pauline moved to Fountain Valley where they have resided ever since. He was a powerful force in the LA Trex and was a great source of advice. A special commemoration was included in the TREX NEWS upon him reaching the age of 100.

PGM Aram is survived by his three children, Aram Jr., Bob, and Linda, seven grandchildren, and seven great grandchildren. Aram will be remembered for his unselfishness, devotion and deep love of family and friends.

He was the kindest human.
