
# FROM THE GRAND MASTER...





### **IN MEMORIAM**



Brother PGM Nickolas Nigosian, Jr. LA, Palm Desert Chapter March 1, 1949 - January 1, 2024

Nickolas Peter Jerry Nigosian, Jr. was born on March 1, 1949 in Burbank, California. He was the second child born to parents, Nick and Gohar Nigosian. His sister, Patricia, who was 13 years older than Nick was like a second mother to him. Nick grew up at the Nigosian family home in Los Angeles on Fairfax Ave. When Nick was young, his father worked as a furrier in Beverly Hills making fur coats for movie stars on Rodeo Drive. In 1955 Nick's father began struggling with his eyesight and ability to sew. He made the difficult decision to give up making furs and decided to purchase a date ranch in the Coachella Valley and learn the date farming business.

The Nigosian family commuted between LA and the desert to their ranch house in Coachella to run and grow the newly purchased business. Nick attended several schools in Los Angeles and enrolled into Black Fox Military School in 1965, for his junior and senior year in High School, where he formed lifelong friendships with his classmates, and developed the skills to be a leader in his community, as well as his confident and playful personality. He graduated from Black Fox in 1967 and went on to attend LA City College and then Pepperdine University.

In 1971, Nick's father asked him to come help run the date ranch. Nick encouraged the expansion of the business by talking his parents into purchasing more land and expanded the business from the original 40 acres to 130 acres across 4 ranches and became a worldwide exporter. Nick loved running the Nigosian's Pyramid Date Gardens and did it for over 50 years.

Nick joined the Junior Chapter of the Los Angeles Triple-X Fraternity in 1970. In 1973, Nick invited Carolon to go with him to a LA Junior Triple-X party, which was the start of their relationship. Nick and Carolon were married in 1975 and lived in Indio and ultimately moved to Indian Wells into the house that they designed and built together.

Their daughter Nicole Michelle was born in 1981, and their son, Michael Nickolas, was born in 1987. Nick was an adoring father, always very involved in both of his children's lives and always very proud of their accomplishments. Michael joined the Junior Triple X of Los Angeles in 2007 and is now a very active member of the LA Sr chapter.

Nick was an active Trexman for over 50 years, serving in many capacities in the fraternity, and in 2008 was unanimously elected Grand Master of the fraternity. It was one of his proudest moments. As a PGM he was highly respected and a mentor and role model to his fellow brothers. Nick truly embodied what it meant to be a Trexman, and always made you feel welcome. Nick's closest friends were a group they called the "Hing Yeghpires" meaning 5 brothers. They included PGM Nick, PGM Vaughn Vartanian, PGM Pete Cholakian, PGM John Casparian and PGM Harold Bazarian.

PGM Nick was very involved in the Desert community, holding numerous leadership positions in farming organizations, youth organizations, community organizations and of course the Armenian Church. Everyone knew PGM Nick and he knew everyone.

PGM Nick was very connected to the Armenian Church, both as a child in Sunday School and ACYO at St James. He and Carolon were instrumental in the founding of St Garabed Armenian Apostolic Church of the Desert where they held many leadership roles and made numerous contributions over the years.

Besides his family and friends, PGM Nick loved classic cars and had a beautiful collection of vintage cars. He met many of his closest friends from this hobby, who are planning memorial car shows and events in his honor.

Nick was a generous, kindhearted, fun loving, honest, and well respected man who contributed much to our lives and to this world. He lived a life full of love, laughter, and joy with his family, friends, Armenian community, farming community, classic car community, and found himself among friends everywhere he went.

Nick was diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma in July and fought this battle with a positive attitude. We unexpectedly lost Nick on January 1, 2024. His memory is lovingly treasured by his Wife of 48 years, Carolon, his children, Nicole and Michael, and by all of his family and friends.


Brother Khatchig Jigirian Golden Gate Chapter Born 1938 - May 6, 2023
